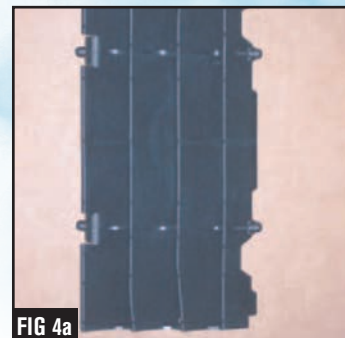
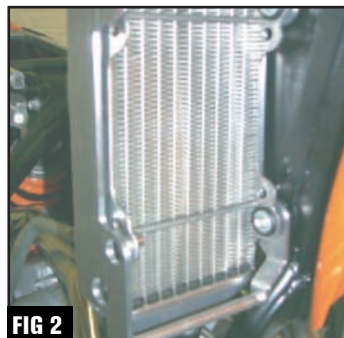


## KTM 4-Stroke Radiator Braces Installation



**1** Remove seat & gas tank.

**2** Remove plastic radiator louvers.

**3** Drain radiator coolant, by removing the radiator cap and then the coolant drain plug on the front of cylinder, or remove a lower radiator hose. (fig 1)

**4** Reinstall coolant drain plug.

**5** Remove the four bolts holding the radiators to the frame.

**6** Loosen the five hose clamps on the top & bottom of the radiators, then pull the hoses off and remove the radiators  
NOTE: If you are also using the KTM radiator fan, you need to remove the fan from the mounting body, by unscrewing the 4 phillips head screws (Fig 6) Then attach the fan on the back side of the right radiator brace using the same 4 phillips head screws. (Fig 7)

**7** Place the brace marked with an R on the back of the right radiator

**8** Install support rods using the supplied 6x16 button head bolts. (fig 2)

**9** Fasten the radiators on to the frame using the supplied 6x16 bolts & the washers from the original bolts along with the supplied spacers (fig 3). On 07' models use the supplied washers with the supplied spacers.

**10** Reconnect radiator hoses & tighten hose clamps.

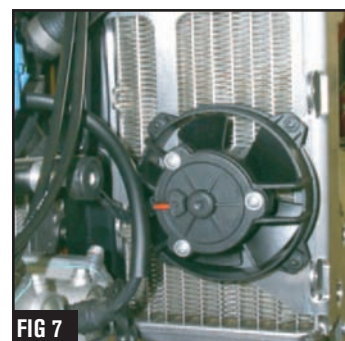
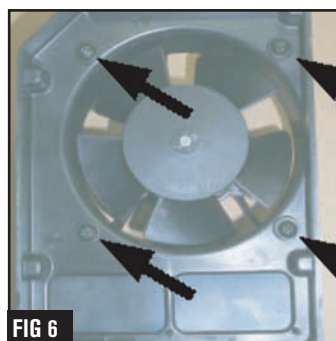
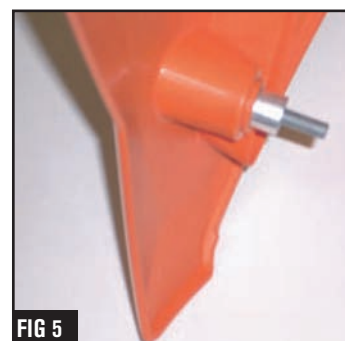
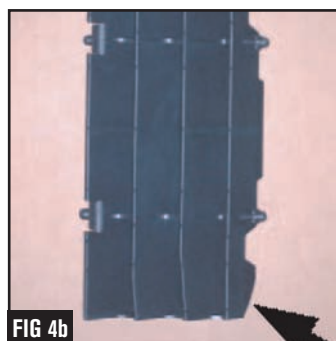
**11** Fill radiators with coolant & bleed the system per your KTM owners manual

**12** With an utility knife, trim the inside lower corner of the plastic radiator louvers (Fig 4b)

**13** Install plastic radiator louvers.

**14** Install tank & seat.

**15** Fasten the radiator shrouds to the radiators by using the supplied 6x30 bolt, standard shroud bushing & the supplied spacer. (fig5)
