

Scorecard Holder Installation

1 Locate the pre-drilled holes in the backing plate. The backing plate is sealed inside the vinyl cover of the scorecard holder. Squeeze the scorecard holder at the top and bottom of the scorecard holder. There are 6 holes. 3 at the top and 3 at the bottom. (Figure 1) We recommended using the 4 corner holes and leave the 2 center holes covered. If that will not work on your bike, use the 2 center holes.

2 Decide which mounting holes will work best. With an Exacto Knife or a razor blade, cut the vinyl cover over the holes you will use.

3 Lay the scorecard holder on the front fender in the position you want to mount it. Use a sharp punch or a Sharpie to mark the hole locations for drilling. (Figure 2)

4 Use a 3/16" drill bit to drill through the fender in the marked locations.

5 Lay the scorecard holder in place over the drilled holes.

6 Push the 4 supplied rivets through the scorecard holder and into the drilled holes in the fender. To secure the rivet you must break off the center pin (Figure 3), flip it upside down, and then push it in the center of the rivet. (Figure 4) Push it in until it is flush with the head of the rivet.
