

Husqvarna Handlebar Riser Kit

1 Take a marker and draw a line across the handlebar and handlebar clamp to be able to put your handlebars back to the current position.

2 With a 12mm socket, remove the 4 bolts that hold on the upper handlebar clamps as shown in (Figure 1).

3 Lift the handlebars up and out of the lower bar clamps. You can strap or zip-tie them out of the way for now.

4 With a 17mm wrench or socket, remove the 2 locking nuts and the 2 cupped washers from under the top triple clamp holding the lower bar clamps to the top triple clamp. (figure 2)

5 Remove the lower handlebar clamps from the upper triple clamp. (Figure 3) Make sure not to lose the original cupped washers on the upper triple clamp. You will need to re-use them.

6 Remove the original spacers from the clamps. (Figure 4)

7 Insert desired height risers on the lower handlebar clamps.

8 Insert both clamps through the upper triple clamp. Make sure that the original cupped washers are installed between the risers and the triple clamp. (Figure 5) Re-install the 2 remaining cupped washers and lock nuts that were removed in step 4 on the bottom of the upper triple clamp. Do not fully tighten the lock nuts yet.

9 Re-install handlebars in lower bar clamps. Make sure they are in the same position that you marked in step 1. Install upper handlebar clamp(s). Tighten the mounting bolts to the motorcycle manufacturer's specified torque.

10 Torque the lock nuts installed in step 9 to the motorcycle manufacturer's specified torque.
